The World Championships for Icelandic Horses 2011 at the “Islandpferde Reithof Piber”

Starting from April 2010 tickets for the World Championships 2011 are available

St. Radegund, March 2010 - From the 1st August 2011 – 7th August 2011, St. Radegund / Upper Austria is hosting the Icelandic Horse's World Championships 2011. Nations from around the world – such as Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Iceland, Netherlands, Norway, Denmark and Sweden - are going to present their horses for more than 50.000 expected visitors in an impressive manner. Starting from April tickets for this high profile tournament can be purchased online at www.islandpferde-wm.at.

The fact that the “Islandpferde Reithof Piber” is very well prepared to host national and international sporting events can be proven by the list of already held tournaments: Hence they have already organized the Austrian Championships, various World Championship-Qualifying tournaments for the IPZV and the FEIF Youth Cup in 2006. "To take part in the competition of organising the best national and international tournaments, good riding venues and only the best track conditions are essential," says Karl Piber, owner of the “Islandpferde Reithof Piber”, who is already an expert in building high quality tracks. He has invested a lot of time and due diligence in the construction of an extremely weather-resistant track with elastic, springy ground which offers the ideal conditions for both horses and riders. The results speak for themselves: contracts for the construction on a national and international level could have already been achieved by Karl Piber. The outstanding quality of the tracks in St. Radegund has been confirmed again and again by riders from Germany and abroad. In addition to the perfect track the “Islandpferde Reithof Piber” offers ideal training facilities for both ambitious sports - and leisure - riders: Dressage Squares (20x40m and 20x60m), an indoor riding school (20x40m), two oval tracks (250m), as well as two pace tracks and a lunging ring (20m).
